

In a first of its kind, the Donna Independent School District has scheduled two back-to-back COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics to take place this Thursday, March 25th.

The first scheduled COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic for the community will be hosted by Donna ISD and Hidalgo County in partnership with Hidalgo County Health Department, Hidalgo County Precinct 1, City of Donna and South Texas College. Approximately 1,000 doses of the Moderna vaccine will be available.

This first dose clinic will take place from 8:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. at the Donna High School campus located at 2301 East Wood Ave. Members of the public interested in receiving the vaccine must register through Hidalgo County's new online COVID-19 vaccine registration system.

In its first collaboration with the supermarket giant HEB, Donna ISD will be hosting its second COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic solely for district employees.

This first-dose clinic will take place from 1:00 p.m.-5:00 p.m. at the Donna North High School campus located at 7250 Valverde Road. Approximately 500 doses of the Pfizer vaccine will be available. In addition to HEB healthcare workers, Donna ISD will also provide nurses and health aides to help administer the vaccines.

Donna ISD staff members had the opportunity to express their interest through a district online platform emailed to them earlier this week. Those who are interested, must register through the HEB link and sign-up for a specific appointment time and complete additional paperwork. They will also be asked to print a consent form included in the link and bring it with them to the clinic.
