

As per CDC guidelines the following protocol is in place:

Students that have any ILI symptoms (Influenza like symptoms) **will be sent home...**

- Fever over 100.0
- Headache
- Cough and or
- Sore throat
- Vomiting (sometimes)
- Diarrhea (sometimes)

Any student or staff with ILI symptoms will be required to seek medical attention.... and present a medical clearance upon return to work or school.

Any student with severe coughing or sneezing while waiting to be pick up by parents will be kept in isolation and **will be asked to put on a mask while they are waiting in the clinic.** Parent will be notified about the mask as a courtesy, this is being done to protect the student as well as other students and staff in the clinic.

Any student that is vomiting or has diarrhea will be sent to the clinic for evaluation Nurses will notify custodial staff to clean bathrooms, floors, or emptying trash cans. Custodial staff will be encouraged to wear PPE while cleaning, disinfecting, emptying or handling trash containing body fluids or wastes. Nursing staff will PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) while handling any body fluids or body waste.

*\*PPE includes gloves and masks*
